DIRECTOR'S NOTE

For as long as I have been directing here at Pascack Hills, the students have been asking me to choose *Mamma Mia!* for our spring musical. Over the years I've deflected the topic, saying the show is too overdone, pointing to other schools in our proximity who were putting it on, or even blaming our music director Nicole D'Angelo's general disdain for jukebox musicals - something that's become an in-joke with many of our cast members. However, I knew that this year, with this group of students, *Mamma Mia!* was the perfect choice.

Though Nicole may jokingly (??) disagree, *Mamma Mia!* is a fan-favorite for a reason. It's not just the Abba songs that audiences can't help but sing along to, or even the popularity of the 2008 film adaptation. I believe *Mamma Mia!* pulls off the very difficult challenge of taking incredibly well-known existing IP and transcending it into something greater than the sum of its parts. The show explores themes of chosen and found family, self-discovery, what it means to be a parent, the chaos and comfort of love, and how to navigate life's unexpected moments with humor and grace. Just as Sophie is searching for her own sense of identity, high school students are in the process of finding themselves, through their relationships with their families, friends, and their own self-expression. Grounded by its heart-warming central message that it's never too late to be honest with yourself or share your feelings, *Mamma Mia!* will make you want to laugh, cry, and, of course, get up to dance in your seat!

I would like to thank my production team, cast, crew, student designers, parent coordinators, and volunteers for all the hard work they put into this production. This show has been a true labor of love for all involved. Without each and every person's contributions, the incredible show you are about to watch would simply not be possible. I would also like to thank Principal Wieland for his unwavering support of our program - I don't know many principals who would set aside their own busy schedule to sit in the auditorium all afternoon to supervise a last-minute set build. We are forever grateful for all that you do! Thank you as well to our entire administration, faculty, security staff, Superintendent Bilotti, the Board of Education, and our rock-star custodial staff who put up with our late nights and occasional messes!

SYNOPSIS

On a small Greek island, Sophie dreams of a perfect wedding — one which includes her father giving her away. The problem? Sophie doesn't know who he is! Her mother Donna, the former lead singer of the 1970s pop group Donna and the Dynamos, refuses to talk about the past, so Sophie decides to take matters into her own hands. Sneaking a peek in her mother's old diaries, she discovers three possible fathers: Sam, Bill, and Harry. She secretly invites all three to the wedding, convinced that she'll know her father when she sees him. But when all three turn up, it may not be as clear as she thought! Told through the legendary music of ABBA, *Mamma Mia!* has become a worldwide sensation that has audiences everywhere dancing.



THEATER ETIQUETTE

- Arrive on time.
- Visit the restroom before the performance begins.
- Turn off your cell phone or, if it must be on, put it on vibrate.
- Do not text during the performance.
- Pay attention to announcements that are made prior to many shows about the rules of the theater you are attending and the location of the fire exits.
- Don't speak during the performance...whispering is still speaking, so only in an emergency.
- Do not take pictures during the performance. It can be very distracting to the actors and can cause a mishap.
- Remain in your seat for the entire performance. If you must leave, exit during intermission. In an emergency, wait for an appropriate break in the show. It is rude to get up in the middle of a quiet moment...rude to the actors and your fellow audience members.
- Do not eat or drink in the theater. If you must have a cough drop, or something of that nature, do not make noise with the wrapper.
- Do not put your feet up on the seats or balcony and do not kick the seat in front of you.
- Do not angle your head together with your "special someone" as you obstruct the view of the people behind you.
- Do laugh when the performance is funny.
- Do applaud when it is appropriate during the performance.
- Do applaud when the performance is over...this tells the performers and crew that you appreciate their work.
- Stand and applaud if you really thought the show was great!

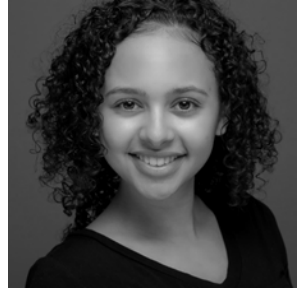

BACKGROUND

Mamma Mia! is based on the songs of ABBA, a Swedish pop/dance group active from 1972 to 1982 and one of the most popular international pop groups of all time, topping the charts again and again in Europe, North and South America and Australia. Following the premiere of the musical in London in 1999, *ABBA Gold* topped the charts in the United Kingdom again. This musical was the brainchild of producer Judy Craymer. She met songwriters Björn Ulvaeus and Benny Andersson in 1983 when they were working with Tim Rice on *Chess*. It was the song "The Winner Takes It All" that suggested to her the theatrical potential of their pop songs. The songwriters were not enthusiastic, but they were not completely opposed to the idea.

In 1997, Craymer commissioned Catherine Johnson to write the book for the musical. In 1998, Phyllida Lloyd became the director for the show.
