DIRECTOR'S NOTE

At the end of last semester, several of my students approached me with the same plea: that I read *She Kills Monsters* by Qui Nguyen and select it for our fall play. Our Stage Manager Eliza Krigsman even leant me her own personal copy to read (thanks Eliza!). Once I read it I knew they were right - we had to do this show. *She Kills Monsters* is unlike any play we've ever done at Pascack Hills. Though it is set in the imaginative world of Dungeons and Dragons, with monsters, sword fighting, dragons, and endless creative possibilities, it is filled with as much humanity as it is fantasy. The main characters may be Paladins, Demons, Elves, and Faeries, but they are deeply human through and through, with wants, needs, hopes, dreams, and fears that speak to the teenage experience. And our heroine Agnes, a well-meaning sceptic, offers our audience a way into this magical world, helping those who have no familiarity with D&D to join in the fun, learn about the ever popular role-playing game, and to shed all judgments and prejudices along the way. With themes of grief, identity, self-discovery, and hope, *She Kills Monsters* truly speaks to the inner geek in all of us.

From an educational standpoint, *She Kills Monsters* offered our students a chance to learn a brand new, exciting skill: stage combat. Our Fight Director Robert Aronowitz is co-founder of NYC's premiere stage combat school, Neutral Chaos Combat. Together with Fight Assistants Alli Green and Simon Kiser, Rob taught our actors (and some of our running crew!) how to safely execute the basics and brought each wacky and hilarious fight scene to life. The result is some of the most fun we've ever had in the Hills Auditorium!

She Kills Monsters also offered the opportunity to tell an explicitly LGBTQ story, from the brutally honest perspective of a high school student in the 1990s. We are lucky to live in a community where many of our students are able to be open and free in living the full truth of their identity. There are some, like a few of our characters, who are still questioning or do not yet feel comfortable enough to come out. We also have many students who are allies to the LGBTQ community looking for ways to support their friends and peers. Having a story with this kind of representation, shining a light on the good, the bad, and the in-between of figuring yourself out and being seen by others, is deeply important for students in this age group.

Whether you consider yourself a "noob" or a level-20 nerd, there is surely something to relate to in our production of *She Kills Monsters*. I hope it inspires you to express yourselves in new or unexpected ways, to cherish the time you have with the people you love, to live out loud in all the wonderful weirdness of who you are, and maybe even to pick up a 20-sided die and roll your way into a Dungeons and Dragons campaign. The only limit, in life, theater, and D&D, is your own imagination.



SYNOPSIS

She Kills Monsters tells the story of Agnes Evans, a young woman grieving for her deceased sister. The Evans sisters never were especially close, but after Tilly's death Agnes receives a notebook containing a game scenario created by her sister. She discovers that Tilly was a well-known Dungeons & Dragons player, and that she was passionate about online fantasy gaming. In order to unlock more secrets about her mysterious young sibling, Agnes recruits a "dungeon master" named Chuck to help her understand and grieve Tilly. Chock-full of supermodel elves, dominatrix warrior women, and nasty ogres, She Kills Monsters is a surprisingly sweet tale of friendship, loss, and acceptance.



THEATER ETIQUETTE

- Arrive on time.
- Visit the restroom before the performance begins.
- Turn off your cell phone or, if it must be on, put it on vibrate.
- Do not text during the performance.
- Pay attention to announcements that are made prior to many shows about the rules of the theater you are attending, and the location of the fire exits.
- Don't speak during the performance...whispering is still speaking, so only in an emergency.
- Do not take pictures during the performance. It can be very distracting to the actors and can cause a mishap.
- Remain in your seat for the entire performance. If you must leave, exit during intermission. In an emergency, wait for an appropriate break in the show. It is rude to get up in the middle of a quiet moment...rude to the actors and your fellow audience members.
- Do not eat or drink in the theater. If you must have a cough drop, or something of that nature, do not make noise with the wrapper.
- Do not put your feet up on the seats or balcony and do not kick the seat in front of you.
- Do not angle your head together with your "special someone" as you obstruct the view of the people behind you.
- Do laugh when the performance is funny.
- Do applaud when it is appropriate during the performance.
- Do applaud when the performance is over...this tells the performers and crew that you appreciate their work.
- Stand and applaud if you really thought the show was great!

HISTORY

She Kills Monsters is hugely popular in high schools and colleges. Nguyen intentionally wrote the characters in a way that allowed for actors of any race to be cast into every role, "We wanted to see the diversity you would find on the New York subway onstage."

She Kills Monsters received its Off-Off-Broadway debut at The Flea Theater in New York City on November 4, 2011, and it ran until December 23. Directed by Robert Ross Parker, the production was performed by the resident company of actors of The Flea Theater called The Bats. The play was presented later at the Steppenwolf Theatre Company in Chicago from February 15 to April 21, 2013. It was directed by Scott Weinstein and it featured the Buzz22 Chicago Company as the cast. The play reprised at the Company One Theater in Boston from April 13 to May 11, 2013, directed by Shira Milikowsky.

Following a 2013 award by the American Alliance for Theater and Education, the play has, as of July 2020, been staged close to 800 times, mostly by high schools and colleges. Some of these productions have done well, including a 2018 production which won a state contest. In response to requests by schools, Nguyen wrote a version of the play, dubbed *She Kills Monsters: Young Adventurers Edition*, that included less profanity and also changed Agnes into a high school cheerleader.






